

COORG ON WHEELS



Coorg on Wheels is a 7-day cycling expedition through the lush forests of Coorg. Known for its biodiversity, Coorg has an amazing green cover with thick canopies of a tropical forest. The expedition starts at our Coorg campus where children brush up their cycling skills and gear up for the challenge.

On this self contained expedition, participants cook their own meals, pitch their tents to set up camp and are involved in planning their expedition. Participants cycle through Vadu Pass, Kabbinkad Junction, Nalaknad Palace and to the base camp of the highest peak in Coorg, Thadiyandamol. A safety jeep follows the group during the ride. On day 7, children return to our Coorg campus for fun activities, initiative games and a celebratory dinner.

- This is a medium difficulty level expedition.
- The participant should know how to ride a cycle.
- Of the 8 days, typically the first 2 and last day are on the Coorg campus. The 5 days in the middle are on the expedition, away from campus and facilities.
- Launched in 2010, over 600 children have been on this program till date.
- This is a popular program and registrations close early.
- Over 95% participants who have attended this program rated it as Awesome and Fabulous.

We have a doctor on our campus. During the expedition we have certified wilderness first aid responders as part of the instructor team.

While on the expedition, participants are expected to contribute and support with camp chores like setting up, cooking, collecting fire wood, cleaning and packing up as per "Leave No Trace" guidelines.

While on the Coorg campus they stay in dorms with built up toilets. During the expedition participants pitch their own tents to set up camp at a different location everyday. There are no fixed toilets and baths on the expedition. Toilet tents are pitched in separate areas for boys and girls. A jeep will carry the supplies, sleeping bags, tents etc. with the group.



We travel by AC buses to Coorg. Departure is from Army Public School, Bangalore at 6:00 am. Reach camp by lunch time. Outstation participants have to reach Bangalore a day prior to departure. Inme provides airport pick up and drop, meals and overnight accommodation facilities at an added cost.



A specific kit list of what to carry is provided at the time of registration.



After the 2 days on campus, an experienced expedition leader with a group of instructors (including ladies) will lead the group. We maintain a 1:5 adult-child ratio.

Inme is India's leading life-skills development organization for children. We run outdoor and adventure based learning experiences for 9-17 year olds. We have six campuses across India that are designed to provide a safe learning environment to help children step out of their comfort zone, while under the care of trained instructors.
