

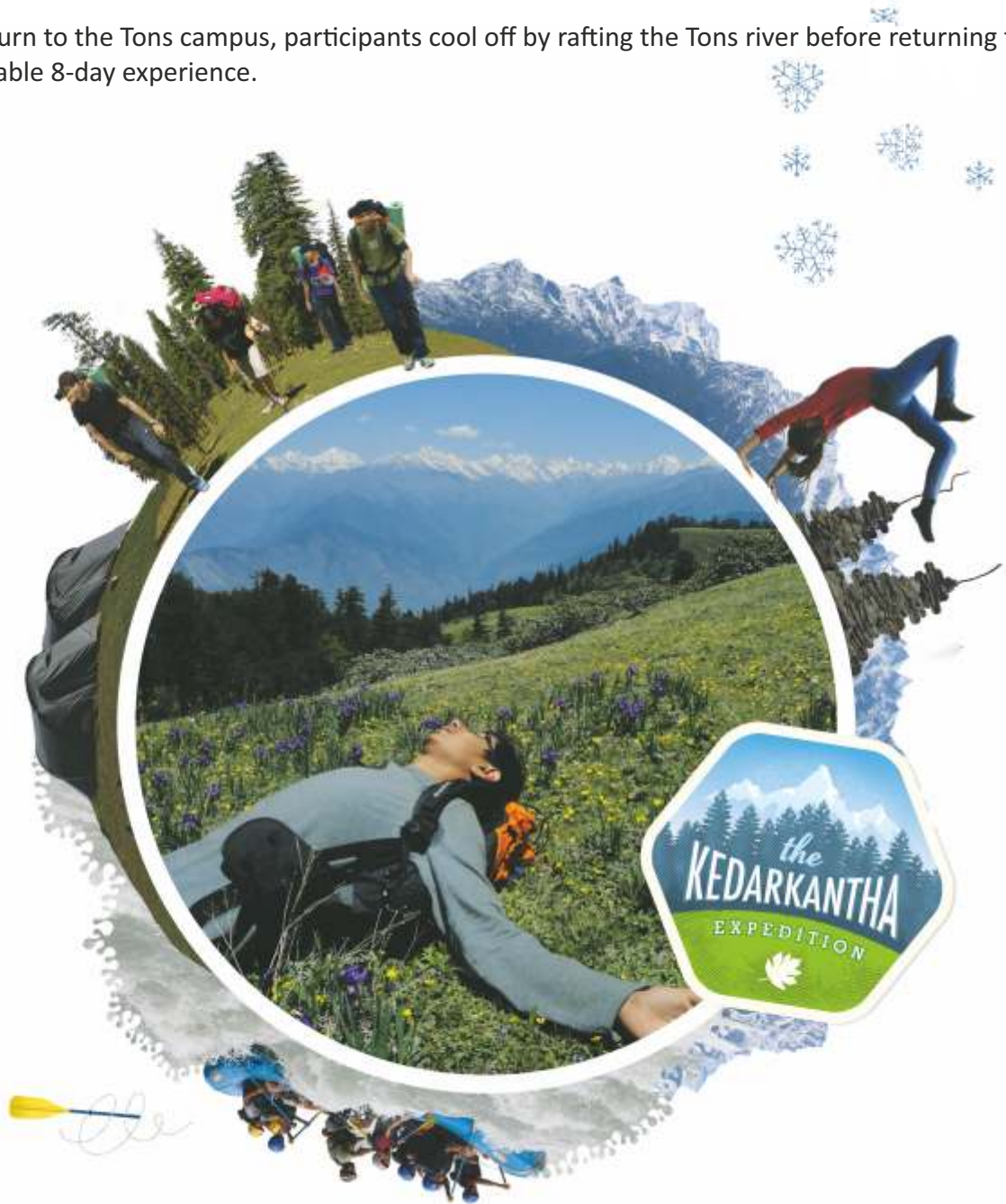
KEDARKANTHA EXPEDITION



This iconic trekking expedition has participants summit Kedarkantha at 12,500 ft, to a breath taking panoramic view of the Himalayas. Hiking through the rocky terrain, the green meadows at *Juda ka Talaab*, and pushing for the summit are experiences that stay with participants for a lifetime.

Our Tons campus serves as the base camp. Participants get their gear and resources, plan the trip and leave for Sankri for the ascent. This is a self-contained expedition where they set camp and pitch their tents at a different location every day. They help with all chores and cooking and manage resources.

On their return to the Tons campus, participants cool off by rafting the Tons river before returning from this memorable 8-day experience.

KEDARKANTHA EXPEDITION



- This expedition has a medium difficulty level
- This expedition meets the requirement of an IAYP Gold level adventure activity.
- Often, the first program of the season encounters some snow and white meadows.
- Back on the Tons campus, the group rafts the Tons river.
- Since 2010 over 650 participants have successfully scaled the peak with us. In addition, we have also led 14 school groups to the summit.
- This is one of our more popular programs, especially for returning participants. We recommend early registration to ensure your seat.

During the expedition we have certified wilderness first aid responders as part of the instructor team.

While on the trek, participants are expected to contribute and support with camp chores like setting up, cooking, collecting fire wood, cleaning and packing up as per "Leave No Trace" guidelines.

Other than the days on the inme campus which has fixed tents and toilets, on this expedition participants pitch their own tents to set up camp at different locations everyday. There are no fixed toilets and baths on the trek. Toilet tents are pitched in separate areas for boys and girls.



The starting point for the program is New Delhi Railway Station. The group travels to Dehradun by AC 3 tier train and onwards to Tons campus in a non-AC buses. Outstation participants have to reach Delhi on the day of the departure. Inme can provide airport transfers, and arrange meals at an added cost.

An experienced expedition leader with a group of instructors (including ladies) will lead the group. We maintain a 1:5 instructor-child ratio.

Inme is India's leading life-skills development organization for children. We run outdoor and adventure based learning experiences for 9-17 year olds. We have six campuses across India that are designed to provide a safe learning environment to help children step out of their comfort zone, while under the care of trained instructors.
