Nagtibba Expedition is our gateway to the world of big mountains for younger participants.

At 9915 ft 'The Serpent Peak' is the highest peak of the Lesser Himalayas in Uttarakhand. The expedition starts with a short acclimatization trek where participants learn to pitch tents and set up camp. Soon it's time to put all of the learning into action and conquer Nagtibba. They trek and set up camp at a different site every day. Everybody chips in the chores and cooking and in managing resources. In the lap of nature, they sleep under the starlit open sky in vast magnificent meadows.

Participants fall in love with the outdoors, forge friendships and conquer new challenges in this exciting adventure!

# NAGTIBBA ASCENT



- The expedition is medium difficulty level with a higher challenge level than an on campus program
- Participants spend 4 days on the trek away from campus and facilities
- The campus has a working kitchen and staff. On the expedition, participants carry their own rations and cook their meals together. The group is involved in planning and resource management as part of the learning.
- 155 participants have conquered the Nagtibba peak, since its launch in 2015
- Over 90% of the participants have rated this experience as Awesome and Fabulous

While on the expedition, participants are expected to contribute and support with camp chores like setting up, cooking, collecting fire wood, cleaning and packing up as per "Leave No Trace" guidelines.

This is an expedition based program with shifting camps where the participants setup their own tents and camp. There are no fixed toilets and baths on the trek. Toilet tents are pitched in separate areas for boys and girls. A jeep will carry the supplies, sleeping bags, tents etc. with the group.



Total Rs. 35,000  
Includes Rs 4,730 travel fee and 9% service tax.



The starting point for the program is New Delhi Railway Station. The group travels to Dehradun by Dehradun Shatabdi and onwards to the campus in non-AC buses/Jeeps. Outstation participants have to reach Dehradun on the departure date.

An experienced expedition leader with a group of instructors (including ladies) will lead the group. We maintain a 1:5 adult-child ratio.



During the expedition we have certified wilderness first aid responders as part of the instructor team.
