
TREK N RAFT



Trek n Raft is Inme's most challenging multi-adventure expedition. It combines trekking and rafting in an 11-day experience for those who want to redefine 'adventure'.

The first leg is a trek to the serene high altitude lake of Ruinsara Taal located amidst picturesque meadows and snow clad mountains. The group pitches its own tents at a new campsite everyday - in beautiful landscapes and *bugiyals* in the Har-ki-Doon area of Uttarakhand. Participants divide roles and responsibilities to manage all the planning, chores and cooking with the course leaders. They return to the Tons campus after five days of trekking.

The thrilling second leg of the expedition takes participants down 60 km on the gushing rapids of the mighty lower Tons. Over three days, participants conquer continuous grade 3+ rapids.

TREK N RAFT



- The challenge level of this program is high
- Participants trek to Ruinsara Taal (11,500 ft) and raft the lower tones (60 km of white water).
- Safety is of paramount importance to us and we partner with Aquaterra Adventures (rated one of the leading operators in the world by National Geographic) to run the rafting leg of the program.
- Started in 2014, the expedition is very popular with 15-17 yr olds.
- All the children who have attended the program have rated it as Awesome and Fabulous!
- Early registration is recommended as we have only one program and run a small group.

The starting point for the program is New Delhi Railway Station. We travel to Dehradun by AC 3 tier train and onwards to Tons campus in a convoy of non-AC buses. Outstation participants have to reach Delhi on the day of the departure. Inme can provide airport transfers, and arrange meals at an added cost.



An experienced expedition leader with a group of instructors (including ladies) will lead the group. We maintain a 1:5 instructor-child ratio.



During the expedition we have certified wilderness first aid responders as part of the instructor team.



The participants are expected to contribute and support with camp chores like setting up, cooking, collecting fire wood, cleaning and packing up as per "Leave No Trace" guidelines. On the expedition, the children and the instructors cook every meal together.



Other than the days on the inme campus which has fixed tents and toilets, on this expedition based program participants pitch their own tents to set up camp at different locations everyday. There are no fixed toilets and baths on the trek. Toilet tents are pitched in separate areas for boys and girls.
