

DEEP SEA ADVENTURE



The Deep Sea Adventure takes you on a journey to discover the amazing world under water. Designed for 14-17 year olds, this expedition involves scuba diving, snorkeling and sea-kayaking. Participants spend time on pristine beaches with sparkling white sands that meet the blue ocean expanding into infinity. An intriguing colonial past and the remnants of a stone age culture have lured travelers to these mysterious islands in the warm, tropical waters.

A well packed schedule keeps participants engaged all day. Stunning, near-deserted beaches, gorgeous coral reefs and marine life is the group's wilderness classroom.

DEEP SEA ADVENTURE



- This is an SSI Scuba Divers' Certification program.
- Other than diving, participants also go Snorkeling and Sea Kayaking.
- There are two open dives to a maximum depth of 12 metres.
- All equipment and technical gear is provided. A detailed kit list will be sent at the time of registration.
- Since 2012, over 450 participants have received their certifications with us.
- We only offer one scuba based program so early registration is recommended.

Wholesome nourishing meals are provided, largely vegetarian with option of eggs for breakfast and non-vegetarian dinners 2-3 times on the program. Other than breakfast, lunch and dinner we provide snacks and refreshments are at appropriate times with emphasis on hydration.

Cost of flight to Port Blair is not included in this cost and has to be booked by the parent.



All participants fly into Port Blair on the 16th of May. Inme team will meet them at the Port Blair airport. Post the program, participants fly out of Port Blair to their respective destinations. During the program, children travel from Port Blair to Havelock by a ferry (3 hours).



Accommodation is at the Megapode resort in Port Blair and Symphony Palms at Havelock, both are much sought after resorts in the Andamans. Rooms are allocated on triple sharing basis.



The group will have adult supervision. During the activity a 1:5 adult to child ratio is maintained (including lady instructors). Trained and certified divers will handle the diving session.
