



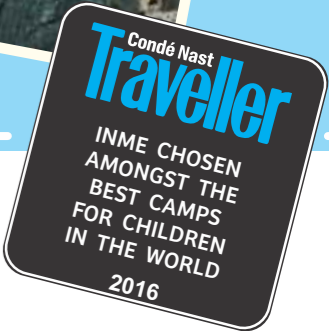
The Discover Program at Karwar is an 8-day residential program that engages children with outdoor and adventure activities, community living, and learning interactions for making them Life Ready.

Our Karwar campus is on the banks of River Kali and comprises of 5-acres forest land. It is 10 km south of the Goa-Karnataka border. The Kali provides excellent kayaking opportunity for beginners. Rock climbing faces, and hiking trails have been developed by us around the campus.

Participants are divided into four to five smaller groups of 15-18 members. 3-4 Trained and experienced instructors (including lady instructors) take care of each group.

While everyone participates in Kayaking as the first activity, the second activity can be either Rock Climbing OR Back Packing. These activities are conducted for three days each.

Outdoor activities are conducted in the first half of the day. Post lunch, participants engage in sessions like initiative games, community service, environmental awareness and village visits. Late evenings are for informal events and campfires.



Accommodation

In Tents and Cabins - separate for boys and girls. Usually 6 children stay in a tent and cabin each with camping mats and blankets provided by us. There are built up toilets and baths with flushing and running water.



Travel

Participants have to fly to Goa on their own where the the Inme team picks them. Travel from Goa to campus in an AC bus (120 kms - 4 hours with snacks break). Please call us for the recommended flight information.



Food / Meals

Wholesome nourishing meals prepared by trained staff. Largely vegetarian with option of eggs for breakfast and non-vegetarian dinners 2-3 times on the program. Other than breakfast, lunch and dinner we provide snacks and refreshments are at appropriate times with emphasis on hydration.



Instructors

A Campus Chief with a team of trained outdoor instructors (including lady instructors) run the program. We maintain a 1:5 adult-child ratio.



Weather

While the morning and evenings are pleasant, days can get a little warm and sultry. However, water access and water based activities help keep things cool.



Doctor and medical facilities

The closest hospital is in Karwar which is 14 km (30 minutes) away. Parents must provide medical details of the participants at the time of registration.
